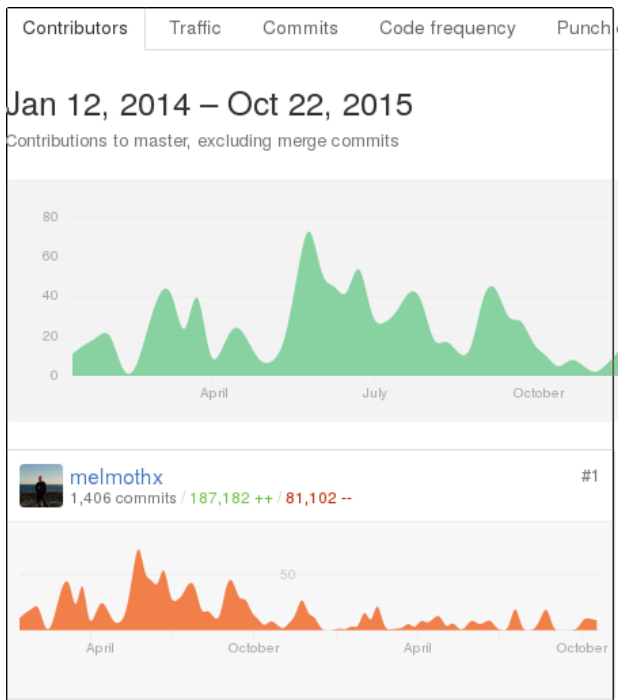

Why?

- Long term storage of texts in a clean form
- Publishing texts providing the best possible reading experience.

Yet another wiki engine

- Flat file storage, one text maps to one file with all the metadata
- Git backend
- High-quality output: LaTeX
- PDF imposing for printing
- EPUB for e-reader and mobile
- Bookbuilder to customize the output and create collections
- HTML importer (supporting copy and paste from Word via ckeeditor)
- Upcoming: slides and POD importer


